OFFICER'S REPORTS

President - Steve Daidone

OPENING COMMENTS FOR CURRENT BUSINESS

He reminded the group that flyers for upcoming shows and the event calendar are available at the BOD table.

Steve also reviewed the sending out the monthly minutes via email. He took questions on interest.

Thanks to John and Mary for their efforts to bring and set up refreshments for each meeting. However, they have decided to officially resign from this assignment at the January 5, 2017 meeting.
