OPENING COMMENTS FOR CURRENT BUSINESS

Steve welcomed everyone to the new meeting location at the Bethpage Library, and thanked Mike Comparetto for making the arrangements. He asked the members if they were happy with the new location and received a positive response. THE BFCU SHOW - Mike reviewed the current status of this year's July 10th BFCU show. Mike is chairing the show with continued assistance and support from Joe Greco. To date, there are 3 vendors and 9 sponsors who contributed \$1950. Contributions were relatively slow during this past month but it is anticipated that financial support will increase during the upcoming months. Vendor contributions go to the Last Hope charity. He asked for the members to inform him of any new vendors/sponsors that want to participate in the event.

MERCHANDISE UPDATE - Mike also gave a merchandise update, which included a discussion about the recently purchased samples of hats; sweatshirts, tee shirts and jackets. They were available for all members' review and purchase at the end of the meeting. Steve also re-reminded the members that LIV jackets including logos and

names on them were available for \$110 for anyone who may be interested.
