The **Plycar Motorama All GM Car Show presented by Long Island Vettes** is scheduled for Sunday July 10, 2022 (Rain date July 17, 2022) at PlyCar's Nesconset location. The show was discussed in detail to bring the members up-to-speed on the arrangements made with PlyCar to date. Show flyers were included in the goodie bags of the TOBAY Beach show on Saturday April 30, 2022. We will need member help to make this show a success. Help is needed for Show Car Registration, Show Car Parking, Tabulation, LIV Booth/Merchandise Sales, 50/50 Raffle Ticket Sales, Show Field Clean-Up, and Judging. A sign-up sheet was available for members planning to work the show. Members can indicate their assignment preferences. A downloadable event flyer/registration form is available on our website, as well as online preregistration using Zelle.

Members bringing their cars have two options:

1. If you just want to display your car while working the show, you should bring your car first thing in the morning when you show up for work (there will be no charge).

Note: This may be amended due to the number of cars we can fit on the property and the number of cars that preregister. This concern was voiced by **Tom Sugar** who pointed out that member display cars could end up in the spectator parking lot if judged cars fill the Plycar lots.

2. If you want to have your car judged, send in the registration form with the required entry fee (\$25.00 pre-registration/\$40.00 day-of-show). Workers will receive a \$10.00 registration rebate after working the show.

There was a discussion about possibly having a walk-through for the members in advance of the July meeting just in case it rains on that evening. The week before the meeting (Monday, June 27, 2022 or Tuesday, June 28, 2022) was discussed, and also whether to have that walk-through in addition to the July meeting or in place of it. It was decided that the full Board will discuss this and let the members know by email.
