August 6, 2026

Treasurer's Report

Rich F. reported on the results of the FourLeaf Federal Credit Union car show:

Four Leaf Federal Credit Union Car Show

178 cars were judged, with a total of 222 total admissions. Those additional cars paid admission but were not judged.

The vendors were very happy with their location along the back wall.

There was a problem when a sudden strong wind lifted a canopy, which had 10-pound weights on each corner, and dropped it on a black Chevy and a '64 GTO. So far, the damage to the Black Chevy is about \$6,900. The cost of the damage to the GTO is not yet known. We have been in touch with our insurance company regarding this and they have been helpful. We expect that in the future our premium will increase significantly.

In the future, participants will not be permitted to have any canopies, even if weighted, and vendors will need to tie their canopies to their trailers.

Also, people working Registration will need to be diligent in INSISTING that any entrant sign the liability waiver before entering, to protect the club.

At the next show we need a few more speakers for the parking area, but to do so we need special wire for the speakers that Tom Sugar gave us.

Terry M. put our club application in Corvettes at the show, but he ran out. This is a great idea for us to do at any show we have in the future.
