Tech questions:

1. Since Dealers get reimbursement for Mobil One from GM, oil changes for the C7 corvettes should be free of charge for 5 service changes.
2. GM being sued for ignition switch problem that was known approximately 10 years in advance to subsequent 12 deaths and multiple injuries. An initial fund of \$600M has been established.
3. 2015 production update: 34,240 corvettes produced, 60.6% Sting Ray coupe, 20.4% Z06, 14.1% convertibles, 4.9% Z06 convertibles; 68% automatic transmissions; most popular color - Artic White, Red - second most popular.
4. Discussion about problems with cars with automatic transmissions.
5. Discussion about problems when turning and paddle-shifting simultaneously.
6. On older corvettes, a discussion involved the cleaning of power switches with lemon juice.
