



LIV Meeting Minutes

July 7, 2016

Meeting opened at 7:30pm with the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

OPENING COMMENTS FOR CURRENT BUSINESS

Steve welcomed everyone to the meeting.

Steve asked everyone for a moment of silence in dedication for the recent passing of fellow member Rich Klein.

He also reminded the group that flyers for upcoming BFCU show are available at the BOD table.

Thanks to John and Mary for their efforts to bring and set up refreshments for each meeting. Thanks to Rich Fingerhut for his continual work in gathering information and updating the LIV website.

Steve announced that this month's meeting will be dedicated to a discussion and final planning for the BFCU show which will be held on July 10th. Mike Comparetto who is chairman for this event discussed the following topics in detail:

1. Support and assistance volunteers will be needed for parking of displaying/judged cars, show registration, vendor parking, and general parking.
2. Volunteers were asked to arrive at 6:30am to start the set up process for vendors and to be prepared for a 7:00am start for vehicle registration.
3. Rain schedule - Since the weather was in question for Sunday July 10, an emergency telephone number was to be put on the LIV website informing everyone if the show would be cancelled, or if any additional information would be necessary.
4. Garbage locations would be set up in advance and located near the vendors where it would be easier for disposal in the dumpsters nearby. Everyone was asked to participate in garbage detail.
5. Merchandise - Mike informed the group that LIV club shirts with sponsor logos would be available for all staff members who participated in supporting the event.
6. 50/50 - Steve mentioned that there will be an attempt to have (2) 50/50 sessions to encourage general population support.
7. End of the show - Trophies would be awarded starting approximately 3:00pm. Once the awards ceremony and 50/50 was concluded the show would be ended.

Steve reminded the group that the LIV Annual Membership picnic will be held at Wantagh Park located at #1 King Road on August 7th and starting at 11:00 AM. There will be a \$10 fee and the event will be catered.

Tony Sorrentino gave a brief budget review stating that at the start of the month the club had \$11,961 in the treasury with an additional \$440 cash on hand for a total of \$12,401.

The 50/50 was collected by Mary Barkey for this month's meeting. \$67 was collected for the winner, who was Doug Brooks.

Approximately 50 people were in attendance for this month's meeting.
