January 5, 2017

Meeting opened at 7:30pm with the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

OFFICER'S REPORTS

President - Steve Daidone - Steve reminded the group that flyers for upcoming shows and the event calendar are available at the BOD table.

Steve also reviewed the sending out of the monthly minutes and other correspondence via email. He took questions on issues and interest.

Thanks to John and Mary for their efforts to purchase and set up refreshments for each meeting. John and Mary have decided to extend their efforts to support the club with refreshments until Johns medical issues are addressed, but volunteers will be required at some time soon. Steve asked for any volunteers to perform this assignment in John and Mary's absence when that time will be required.

The upcoming holiday party costs will be deducted from the current bank account balance.
